In the eyes of the world and the interests that drive it, Jujuy is a favorable place for investing, producing, industrializing, supplying, trading, providing services, and promoting genuine employment. This is because it offers a stable, predictable, and favorable institutional, legal, social, and political environment for economic growth and business development.

This is the result of nine years of effective public policies that are still being deepened and expanded, from the decision to make our province a platform for opportunities, transparency, order, respect, serious rules and clear lines, and values, which are brought together to build an environment of trust.

In this context, the solar plant Chauchari was set to pump 300 mW of clean energy to the national interconnection system and seeks to expand its production capacity to 500 mW. It is incorporated in the distributed renewable energy generation plan, with a capacity of 98 mW to meet the province's demand.

The mining boom is manifested in the global positioning of the province worldwide, taking on an undeniable prominence. In this context, the jewels are the two fully productive lithium deposits operated by EXAR and Sales de Jujuy, along with four others in the drilling phase and two more scheduled to begin drilling in the first quarter of 2025.

Innovation materializes with the production of cannabis for scientific and medicinal purposes through the state-owned company Cannava, which al-

ready exports derivatives to various countries and sells pharmaceutical-grade cannabis oil.

Tourism deserves a distinction, with unstoppable growth and clear upward trend driven by attractions such as the Quebrada Solar Train, the Historic Cabildo, the natural, historical, and cultural sites of Quebrada and Puna, the untamed nature of the Yungas, and soon the Lola Mora Cultural Center.

This wide range of possibilities that constitute the new productive matrix is enhanced with the traditional areas of tobacco, sugar cane, bioethanol and citrus.

For the progress of these projects and others, Jujuy offers an adequate and modern infrastructure that enables logistics and transport, and also secure access to utilities such as energy, water and communications.

The logistics infrastructure is fed by Paso de Jama, General Belgrano Railway, the international airport "Horacio Guzmán", two pipelines and soon, the Load Transfer Station and the Capricorn Bioceanic Corridor, of the most geopolitical importance among the corridors of this type in Argentina.

Additionally, our province has built a strong reputation for peace, governance, and transparency, successfully eradicating corruption and violence.

And, most importantly, Jujuy and investors count on Jujuy people. Our province resists adversities and fosters growth from a trained and competitive work force that can adapt to the companies' needs and contribute to their expansion.

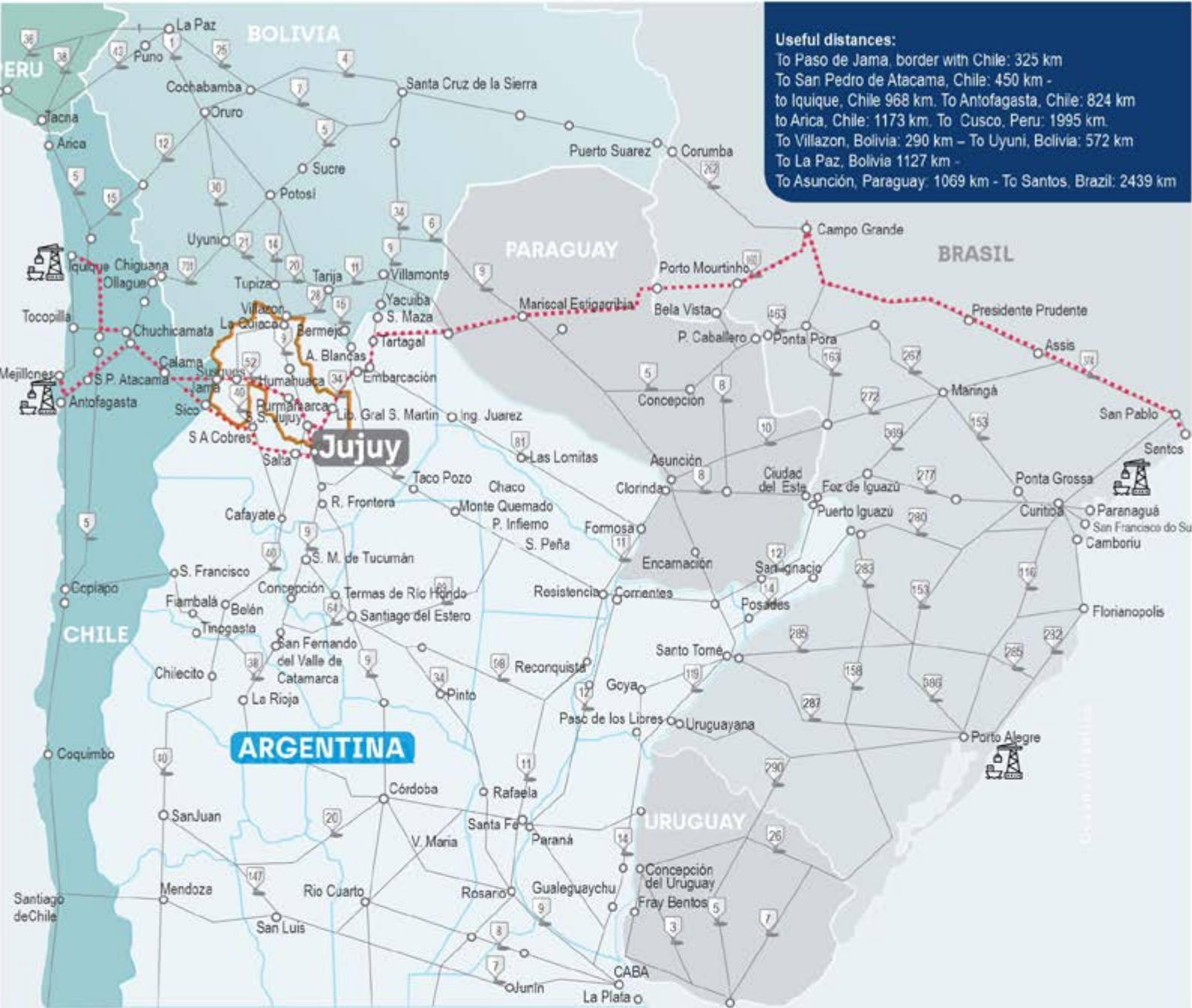

Argentina is geographically located distant from the main international trade routes and from the most important centers of consumption. This has led to prioritize, from a geopolitical point of view, the design and implementation of strategies that foster East-West transit. These strategies are designed to create networks and clusters that promote economic and social sustainable development through regional integration. In this context, the province of Jujuy has achieved considerable progress when consolidating its potential as a central node for commerce throughout the Capricorn Bioceanic Corridor. The location and the infrastructure resources of the province give way and foster the development of opportunities

worldwide, leading to the expansion of productivity frontiers, especially in agro-industrial and mining sectors. The area of influence of this corridor covers from São Paulo, Brazil, to the north of Chile, going through Paraguay and the Argentinean provinces of Jujuy and Salta. It connects the ports of the Atlantic Ocean with the ones of the Pacific Ocean, it goes parallel to the Tropic of Capricorn and covers an important sector of ZICOSUR (Spanish acronym for Area of Integration of Central West South America), constituted by 71 sub-national governments from 7 countries: Argentina, Bolivia, Brazil, Chile, Paraguay, Peru, and Uruguay.







Jujuy is a founder member of ZICOSUR and is currently head of the Commission on Trans-border Security and Facilitation. The province actively participates in processes of integration that promote new axes of growth and consolidate public policies for international integration of sub-national governments. These policies prioritize the interconnection of strategic resources in order to achieve sustainable development, in line with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) of the Global 2030 Agenda. This also highlights the natural projection of the province in trans-border areas.

Argentinian-Chilean technical mixed Group of Integration of NOA (Argentinean Northwest), "Norte Grande" Winter Argentina-Chile Working Group, Argentinian-Bolivian technical mixed Group (COREBE.)

Within this frame and with the transformation boost in the provincial productive matrix during the last years (2015-2023), Jujuy has consolidated as an important recipient of foreign investment in mining, energy, industrial, and touristic sectors. The province has incorporated technology and innovation in the different links of the production chain, creating the necessary conditions for the projection and realization of new productive poles, duty-free zones, industrial parks, logistics and load centers, and also the extension of the International Airport Dr. Horacio Guzmán. These initiatives represent specific opportunities for Jujuy within both the international scope and the local comprehensive development.

Leveraging the comparative advantages and strategic resources in the territory and, with the aim of promoting sustainable and inclusive economic development that places the province at the forefront of progress, internationalization emerges as a solid response to future challenges. This enables to strengthen the efforts to meet the local needs. In this regard, international action, as a cross-cutting public policy throughout the provincial government, finds its focal point in the Secretariat of Regional Integration and International Relations (SIRRI, its acronym in Spanish), which plays a fundamental role in promoting cooperation and regional integration in supra-regional spaces, carrying out numerous actions with a multisectoral approach aimed at capitalizing on strategic opportunities.

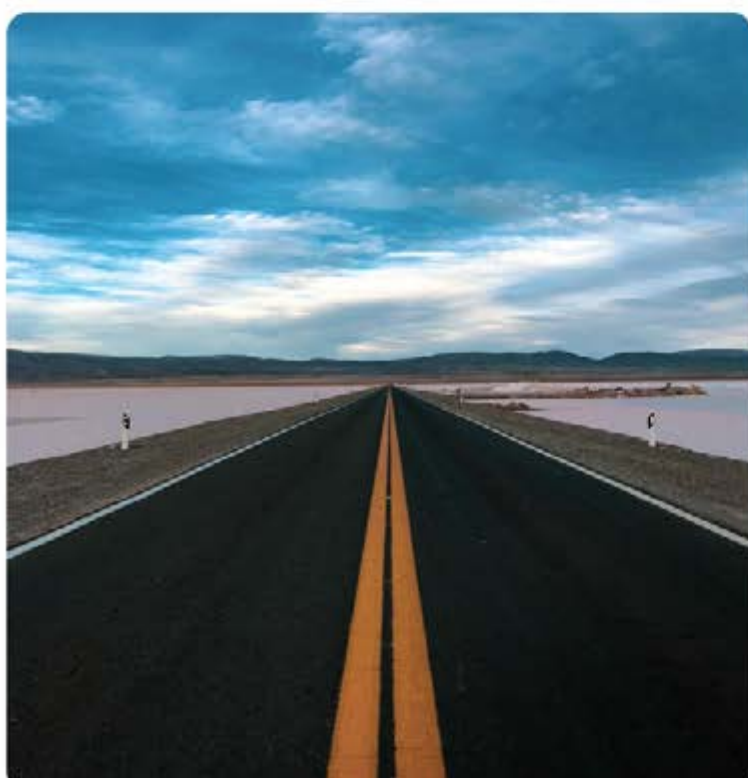
These actions are associated with technological innovation, infrastructure and value chain development, foreign investment, tourism, and cultural industry, key pillars aimed at contributing to the improvement of provincial opportunities in the international stage.

Understanding that we are facing a world full of new challenges, globalization, regionalisms, and decentralization; where the needs to adapt and to be resilient are vital, position and development projects have been designed and coordinated, highlighting the competitive advantages of the region within the Capricorn Bioceanic Corridor and ZICOSUR.

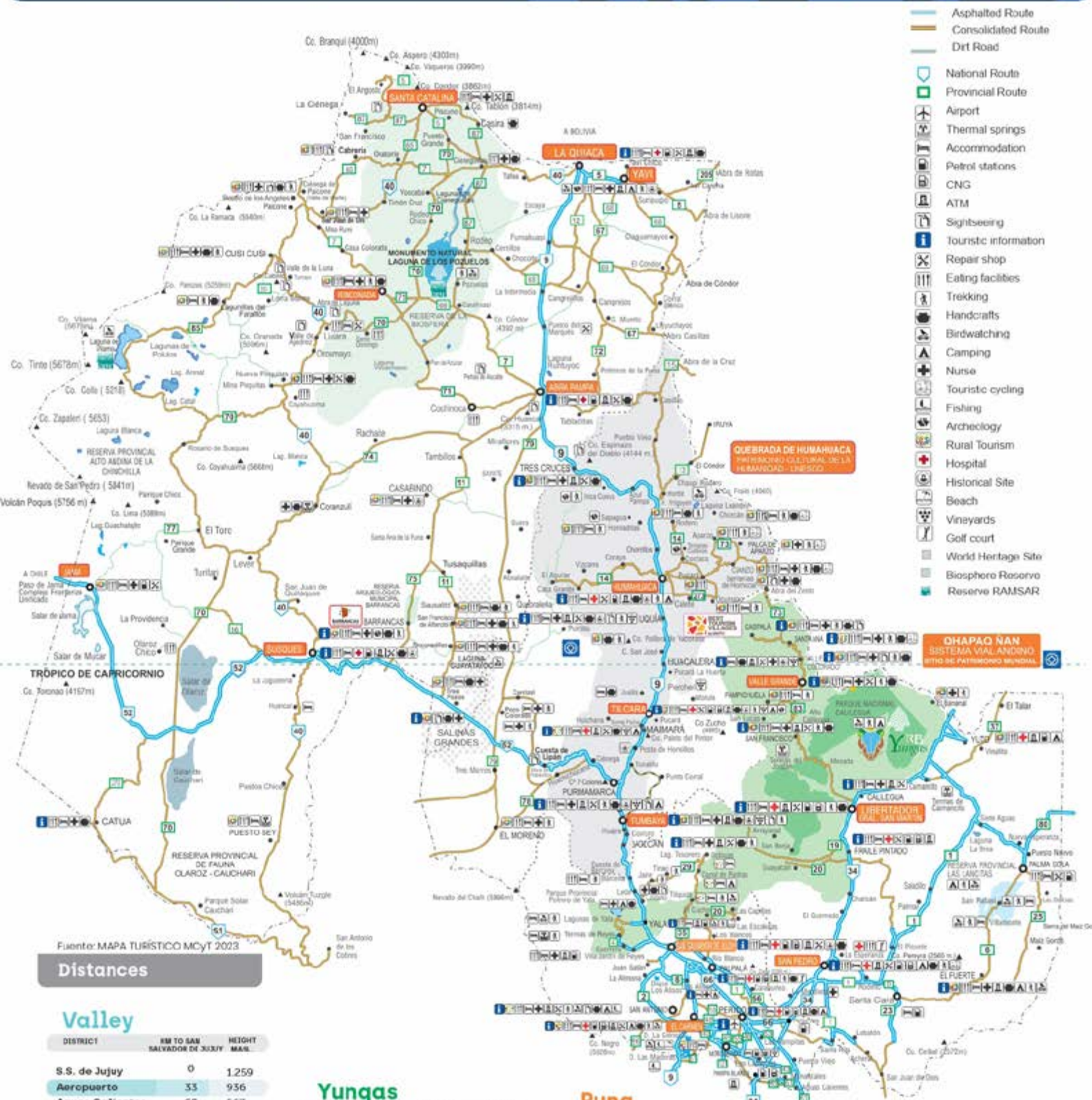
The strategies and actions carried out by SIRRI have many objectives to exercise a facilitating role:  
Regional Master Plan of Integration and Development of the Capricorn Bioceanic Corridor (PM-CBC):

- Trade facilitation and trans-border processes.
- Physical and digital infrastructure.
- Local productive and commerce development.
- Management for facilities infrastructure development in strategic areas (tourism, load flow, people flow, etc.)
- Provincial management to improve efficiency in the functioning of Paso de Jama mountain pass.
- Promotion of the training and technical assistance program led by the Federal Investment Council.
- Study on regional logistics strategies for the great north, developed together with CFI (Federal Investment Council) and the member provinces.
- Inter-ministry Working Group. Bioceanic Corridor Forum.
- Development of joint projects together with credit organisms (Andean Development Corporation -CAF-, Inter-american Development Bank -BID-, FONPLATA, among others.)
- Presidency of the Commission on Transborder Security and Facilitation, coordinating and supporting the growth of ZICOSUR, through the creation of tools from the exchange of best practices in security and border management.

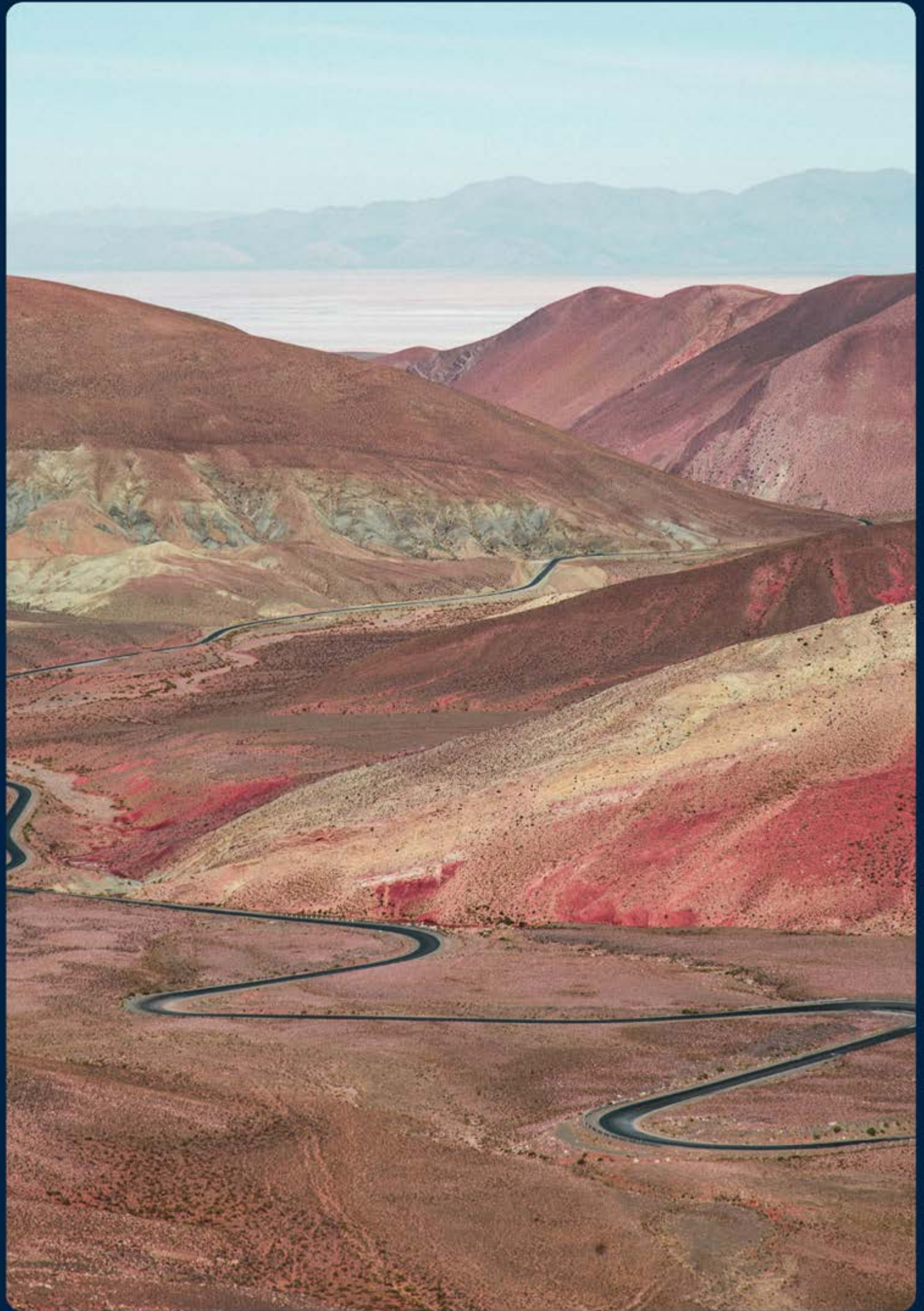

Jujuy is divided into four geographical regions, each one is highlighted by their own diverse landscapes, soils and climates, as well as their high productive and touristic potential. These regions are also rich in their territorial, cultural, and historical heritage, and preserve ancestral knowledge integrated into industrial development in strategic sectors.

### Puna Region:

It is located at 3,500 masl, with a very harsh climate and a large temperature variation range between day and night.

### Quebrada de Humahuaca Region:

Declared a World Heritage Site, it is located between 2,000 and 3,000 masl, with a moderate climate.

### Valleys Region (meridional):

It has a temperate climate with moderate temperatures.

### Eastern Valleys Region (Yungas):

It presents a subtropical climate, high humidity and permanent rain all the year.

## Jama Border Pass

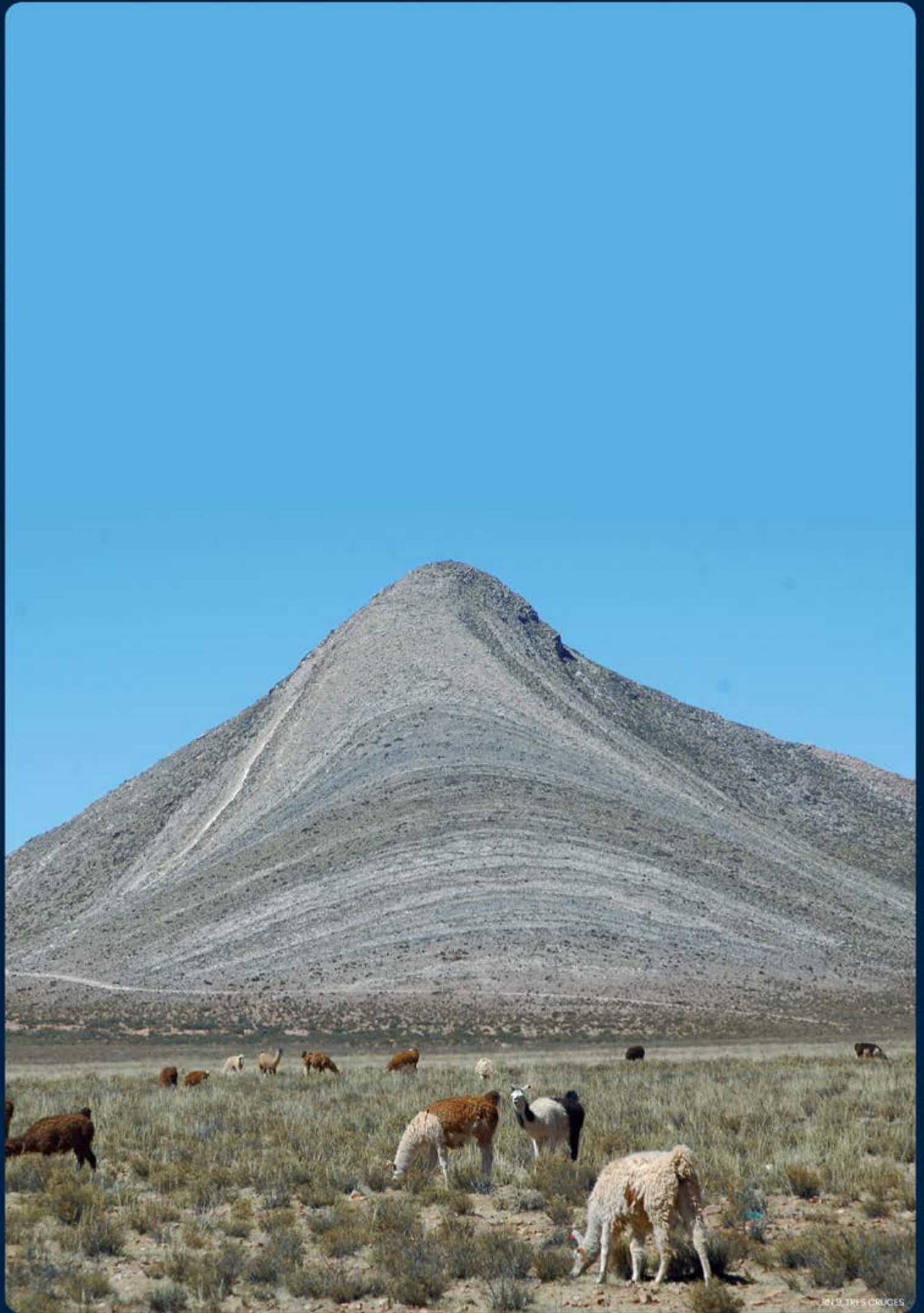
The province of Jujuy experiences high demand for tourism and international commercial transit. National Routes 9, 66, 40, 34 and 52 pass through Jujuy. National Route 52 culminates in Paso de Jama border pass, located in the border of Argentina and Chile. This pass links both countries through the Capricorn Bioceanic Corridor (Atlantic-Pacific), connecting the ports of Chile and Brazil.

Currently, Paso de Jama is the second most important border pass between Argentina and Chile after the international pass Los Libertadores (Mendoza), due to both its infrastructure and its weather conditions, reflected in its operating volume. The route starts at 936 masl and reaches 4,173 masl. It features maximum longitudinal slopes of 6.37%, with radius of curvature greater than 25 meters, and a roadway width of 7 meters. The route is totally paved, enabling safe transit of all kinds of cargo transport vehicles.

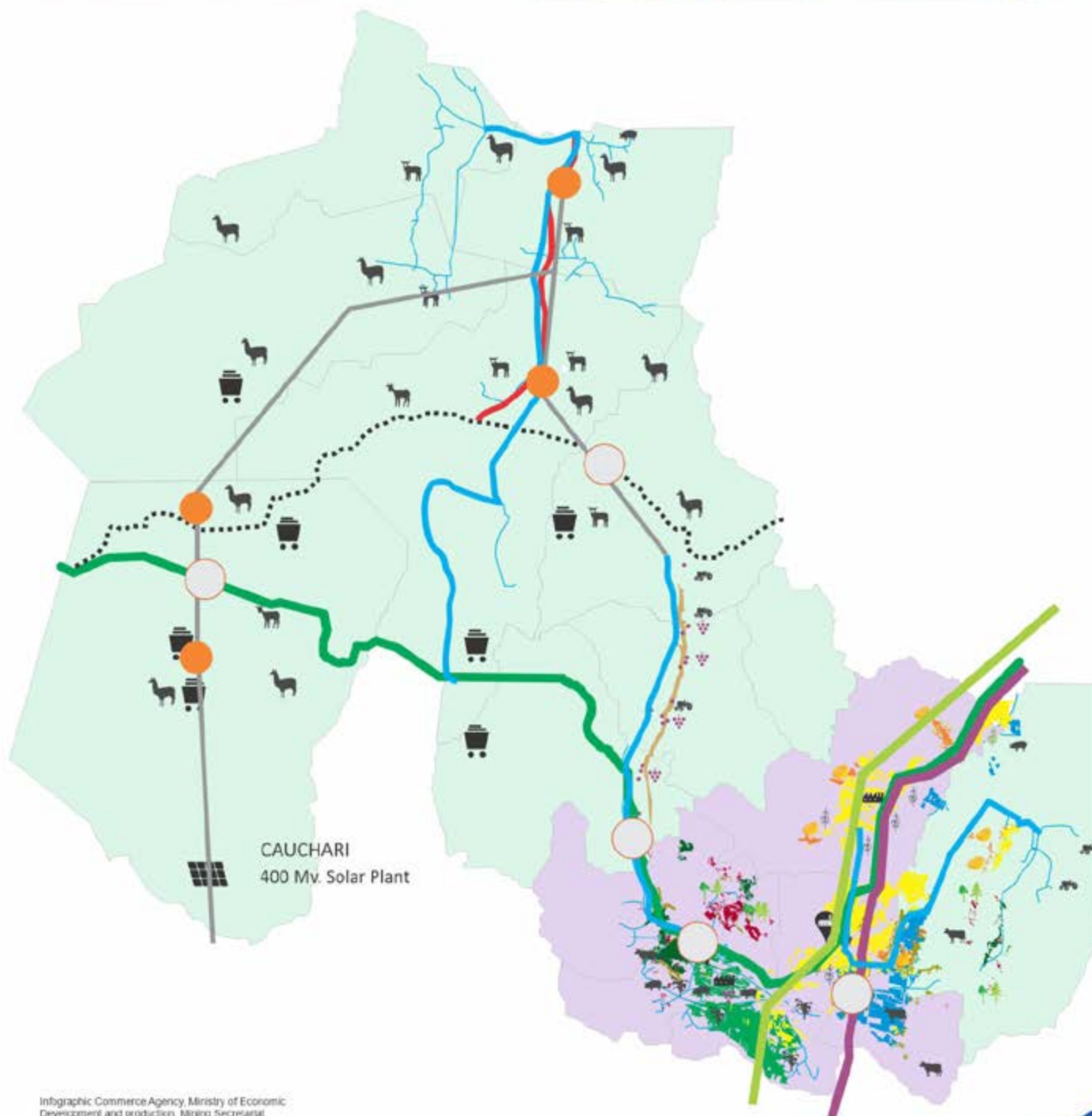
## La Quiaca Border Pass

The international bridge Horacio Guzmán connects the Argentinian city La Quiaca with the Bolivian city Villazón, in Potosí Department, going through River La Quiaca. The access is located to the South of National Route 9, and, to the North, through Route 14.

One of the main objectives of the General Directorate of Industry and Commerce, depending on the Secretariat of Industry and Commerce of the Ministry of Economic Development and Production of Jujuy, is the promotion of industrial parks and the creation of the necessary conditions that attract more provinces to the province, generating genuine job possibilities for the people of Jujuy.

Diverse productive activities have been developed in the Valleys, including agriculture and manufacturing. The production sector has also been strengthened by the growing demand for products made out of medicinal cannabis.

## Industrial Parks

Industrial parks are areas specifically designed for the establishment of industrial and service companies. These parks aim to respect the specific characteristics of each region and are located aligned with domestic development plans. They have infrastructure and services that favor the growth of small and medium enterprises in the national territory.

## National Program for the Development of Industrial Parks

The objective of Industrial Parks, dependent on the National Ministry of Economy, is to encourage territorial organization, to promote productive planning, and to foster cooperative and associative schemes. Its purpose is to improve the efficiency of small and medium enterprises, to increase industrial added value, and to promote the creation of new jobs.

This program was created through Decree N° 915/2010 and regulated by Resolution 40/2010, establishing the following lines and actions:

Register of National Industrial Parks (RENPI in Spanish): Management of register, update, modification and cancellation of the register of industrial parks.

National Census of Industrial Parks: 2020 survey aimed at contributing to the design of productive public policies.

National Observatory of Industrial Parks (ONPI, in Spanish): A space of coordination and decision-making on the allocation of benefits from the National Program for the Development of Industrial Parks.

## Industrial Parks Data

There are more than 400 industrial parks in Argentina in almost all the provinces, being Buenos Aires the host of more than a third of them. However, only 14 provinces have enacted provincial laws that promote, regulate, and boost the development of industrial parks in their respective territories.

### Law n° 5670: Industrial and Service Clusters in Jujuy

In Jujuy, Law n° 5670, passed in 2010, establishes the system for the Creation and Operation of Industrial and Service Clusters. This law regulates the creation and management of such clusters in the province. Regulatory Decree n° 9325/2010 "Request for Establishment and Prior Consultation" designates the Directorate of Industrial and Commercial Development as the authority to enforce the provincial system.

The law defines industrial and service clusters as "authorized areas for the establishment of manufacturing and service activities, supplied with infrastructure, shared services and equipment."

### Categories of industrial and service clusters

The current legislation classifies clusters into four categories:

- a) Industrial Park.
- b) Industrial services and logistics area.
- c) Business incubator.
- d) Associated productive units.





For the private sector interested in investing and producing in Jujuy, this provincial policy translates into an opportunity which offers important possibilities to outline:

1. They offer productive complementarity among companies and favor urban planning, ensuring effective reciprocal protection between industrial activity and other possible uses of the land, which will allow greater control and protection of the environment.
2. They provide infrastructure, services and security, allowing industrial companies installed in these areas to share these resources.
3. They seek the industrialization of local production, adding value to economic activity.

The following industrial parks and service and logistics areas are currently located in the province of Jujuy:

**Ledesma Industrial Park:**

This park is located in Libertador General San Martín and covers 224 hectares, including Ledesma factory premises and surrounding lands. It promotes the installment of new companies with low environmental impact, within the frame of circular economy.

## Perico Services and Commercial Industrial Park:

Located on the banks of the Perico River, near the intersection of National Route 66 (highway) and Provincial Route 10, this park is located on a gently sloping riverside terrace and close to the urban area of Perico. Its location stands out for its excellent connectivity through the road and rail network, facilitating access and the transport of goods.

### Registry:

First Industrial Park in Jujuy, with a registration number RENPI.

### Infrastructure:

53 lots, with 20 companies in operation and approved investment projects for new companies.

## Areas:

Agrifood, recycling, plastic and chemical industries, sale of road and agricultural equipment, energy companies and generators. Recently, there are also companies in the mining sector.

## Projections for 2024/2025:

### Extencion:

19 additional hectares divided into 12 new allotments for industries and companies, focusing on logistics companies and suppliers in the mining industry

Located in the Bioceanic Corridor, Perico Free Zone is a key point in international trade with preferential access to global markets. It offers exemption from national taxes, facilities for the import and export of goods, and a favorable environment for investment.

**Opening: October 2023, with 10 companies by November 2023.**

**Job creation: Estimated 1,500 to 2,000 direct jobs in the initial stage.**

**Benefits: Exemption from national taxes, facilities for international trade, and attraction of foreign investments.**





## Mining Hub:

The Perico Free Trade Zone complements the Lithium Hub in Jujuy, enabling the import and export of raw materials, equipment and products related to the lithium industry. This strengthens Jujuy's position in the global market for batteries and renewable energy.

## Additional benefits:

### Technical assistance:

1. Advice on administrative, technological and financial aspects.
2. Benefit cap: 10% of the funds budgeted per year, 50% of the investment project.
3. Excluded activities: Public service concessionaires, financial activities, real estate services, gambling.
4. Conditions: They should not have debts with provincial organisms or have a current payment plan.



The aim of the Investment and Employment Promotion System, set by Law n° 5922 and amended by Law n° 6081, is to promote a favorable ecosystem for the increase and improvement of investments within the province of Jujuy. It looks for the genuine creation of jobs, social development and economic diversification.

## Possible Beneficiaries:

Natural or legal persons domiciled in the Jujuy territory.

## Requirements:

Existing companies that generate an expansion of their manufacturing or services production capacity, quantitatively and/or qualitatively improving the offer. It is a condition that the existing jobs at the moment of applying for the benefit are maintained or expanded and the following requirements are met:

- Effective expansions in fixed assets affected by production: minimum 10%.
- Job creation: at least 5% of the permanent staff.
- Requalification of employees: at least 1% of the permanent staff.

## New companies:

New companies must attest the completion of an investment project. They are classified as

## New goods and services:

Goods and services not produced in the domestic market, which use local raw materials or local inputs and/or human resources mainly from the area or zone of establishment.

## Existing goods and services:

Goods and services already generated in the domestic market will have up to 50% of the different benefits provided for in the Law.

When granting the benefit(s), the following features will be taken into account:

- Investments aimed at certifying quality systems.
- Adequate processes to certify investments in systems aimed at preserving the environment.
- Replacement of traditional energy with renewable energy.
- To promote the development of local suppliers and the integration of productive chains.
- Technological innovation (products-processes.)

## Promotional benefits:

Exemption or reduction of provincial taxes:

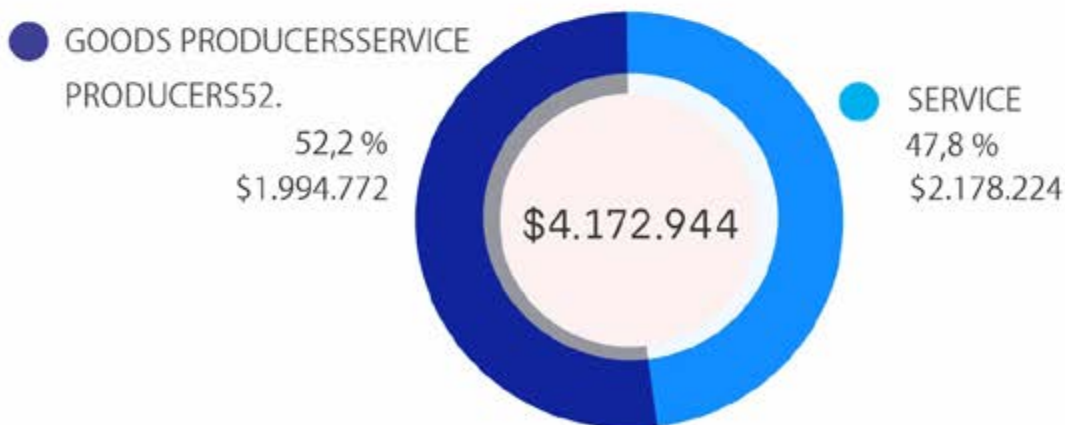

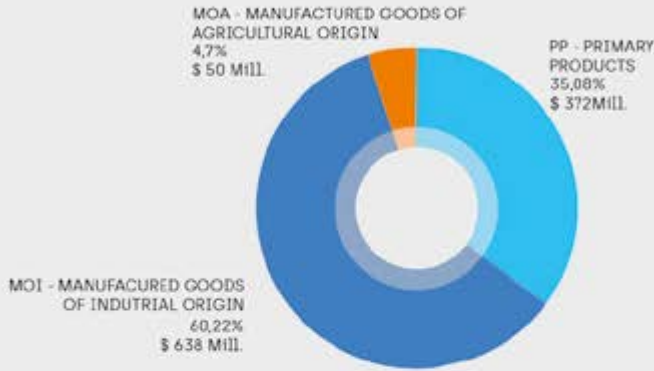

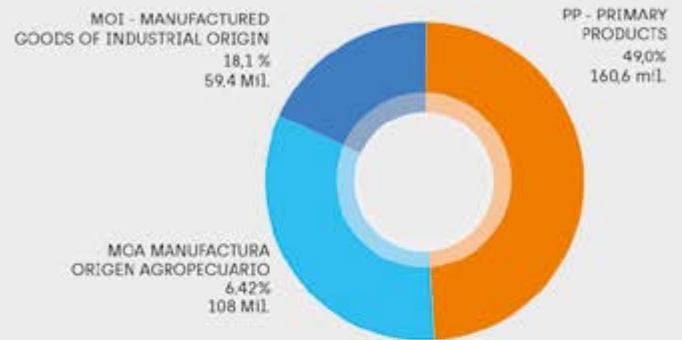

**EXPORT BY AREA EXPRESSED IN MILLION OF KG**



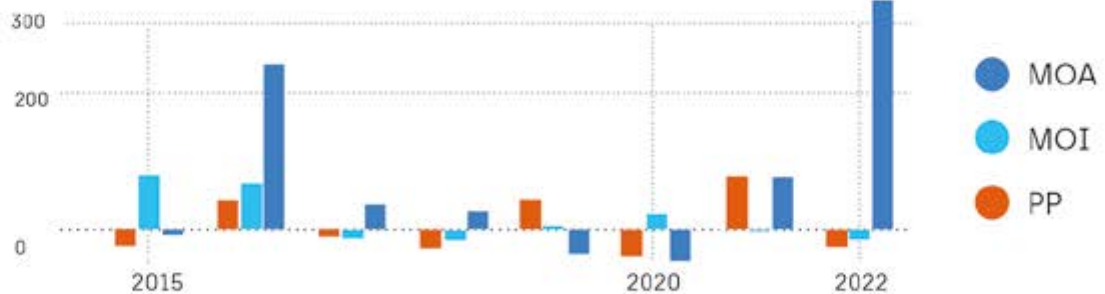

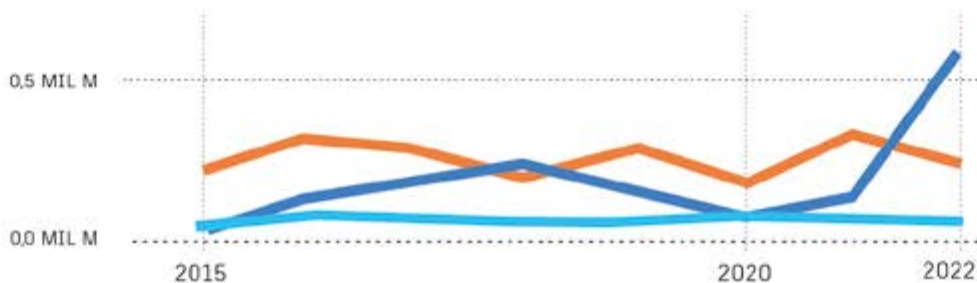
Export Participation in KG by sector according to category



**VARIATION OF ALL EXPORTS YEAR 2015 - 2022**

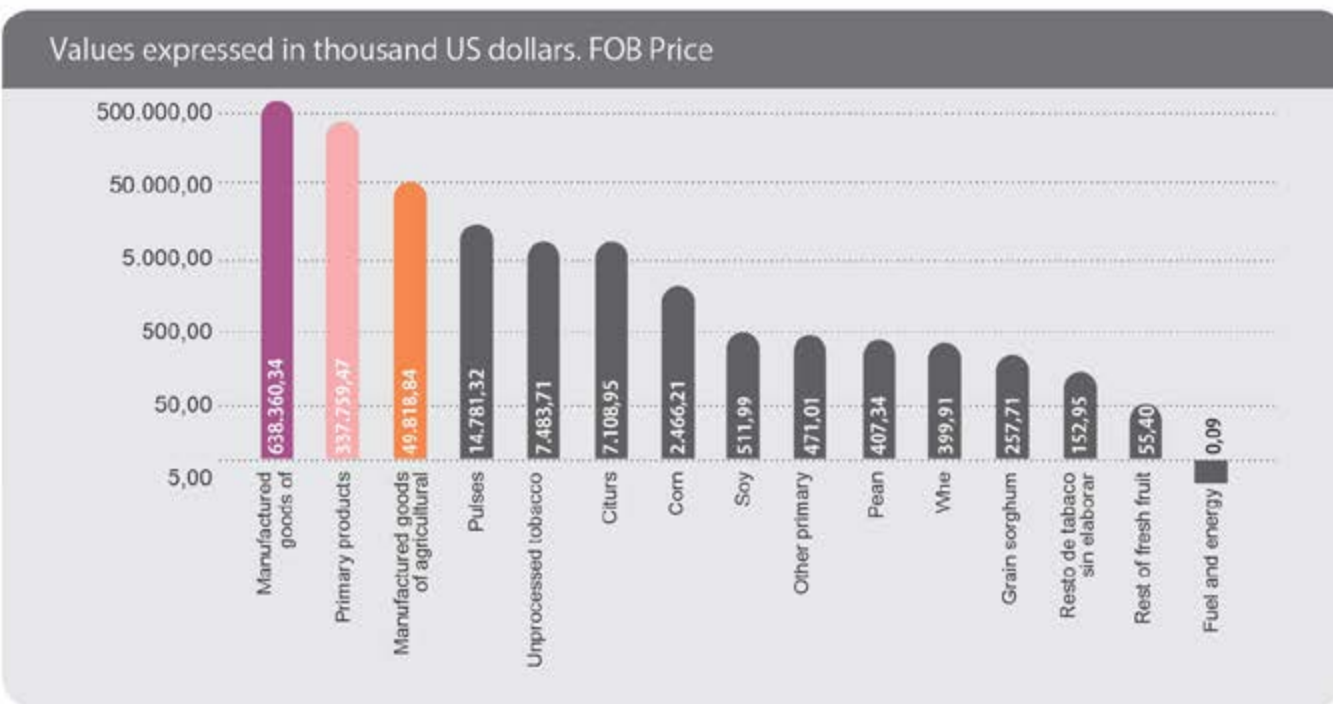

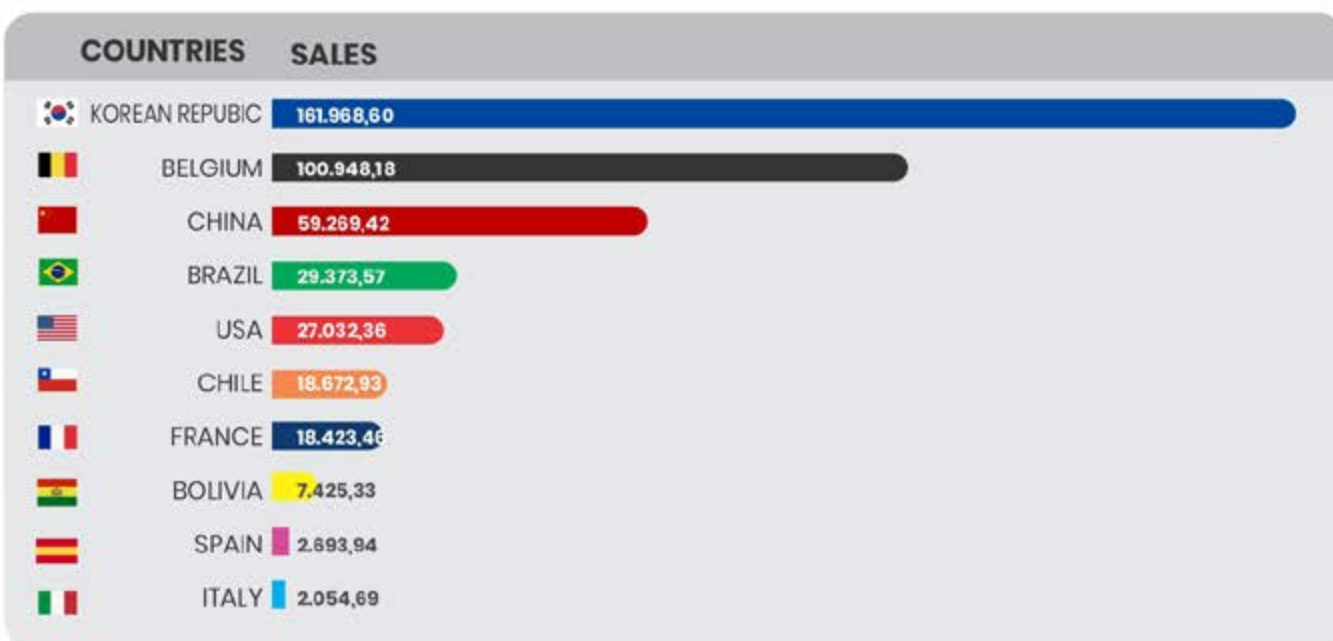

### SCOPE OF EXPORTS OF PRODUCTS ORIGINATED IN JUJUY DURING 2023



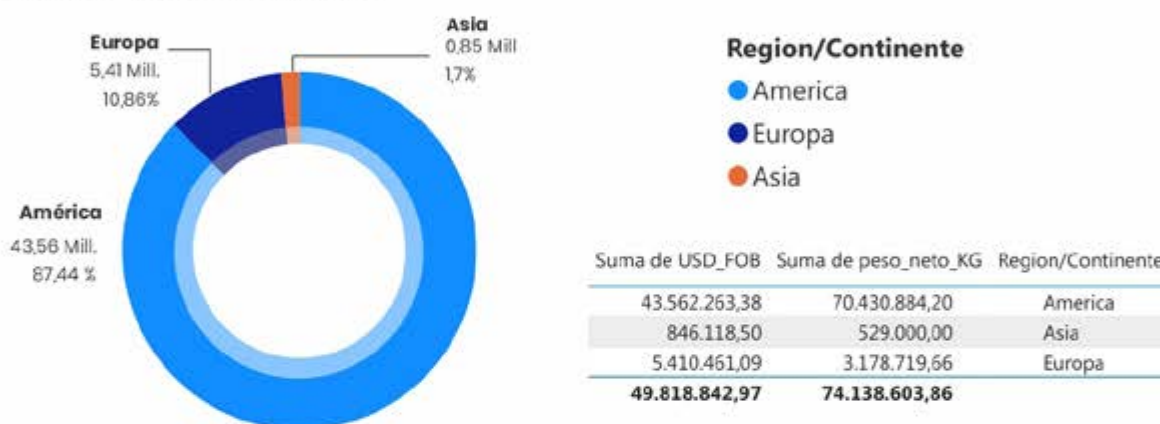

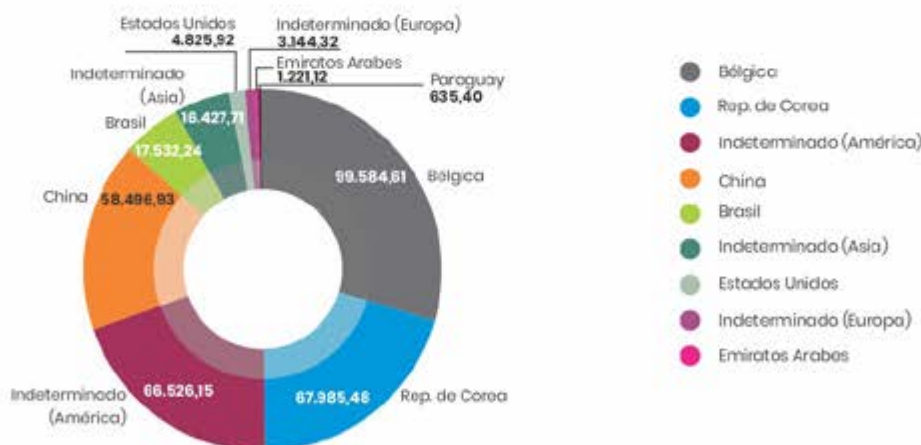
## EXPORT OF MANUFACTURED GOODS OF AGRICULTURAL ORIGIN

Countries/regions that most consumed manufactured goods of agricultural origin from Jujuy during 2023. FOB price expressed in thousands of dollars

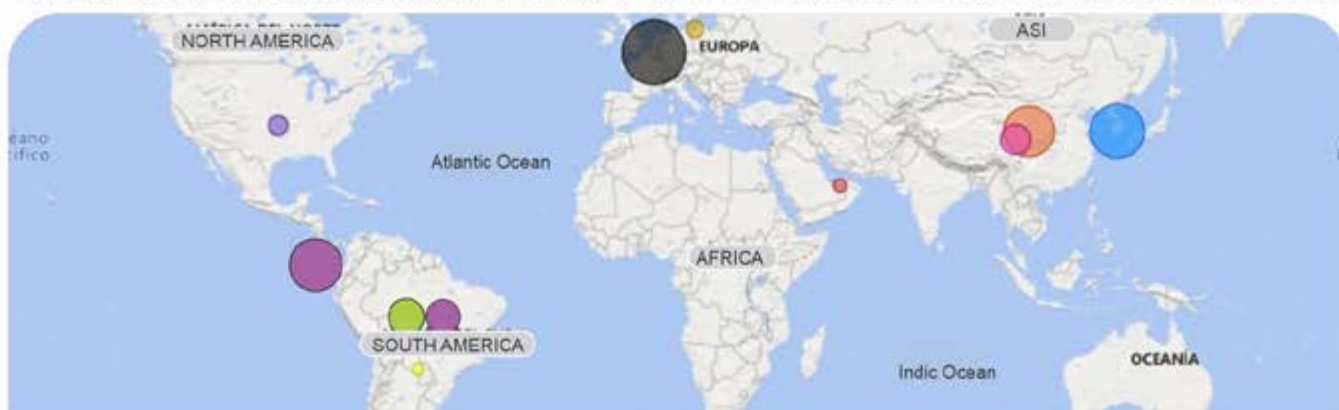


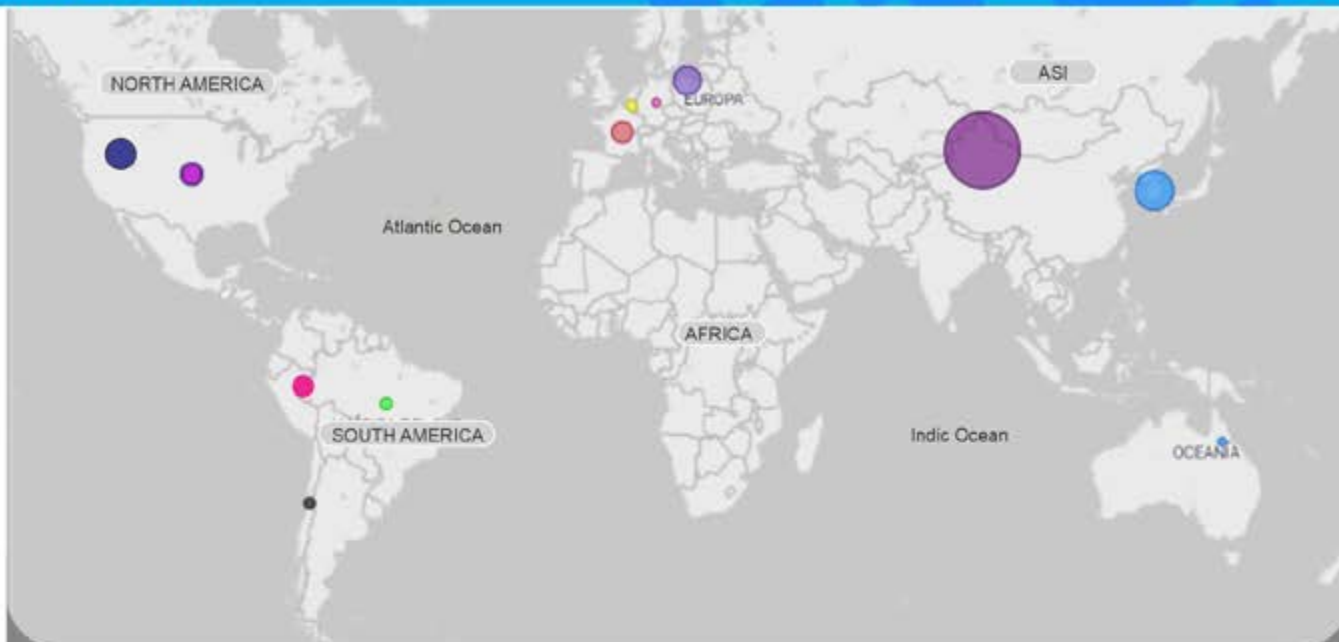
## EXPORT OF PRIMARY PRODUCTS

Countries/regions that most consumed primary products from Jujuy during 2023 FOB price expressed in thousands of dollars



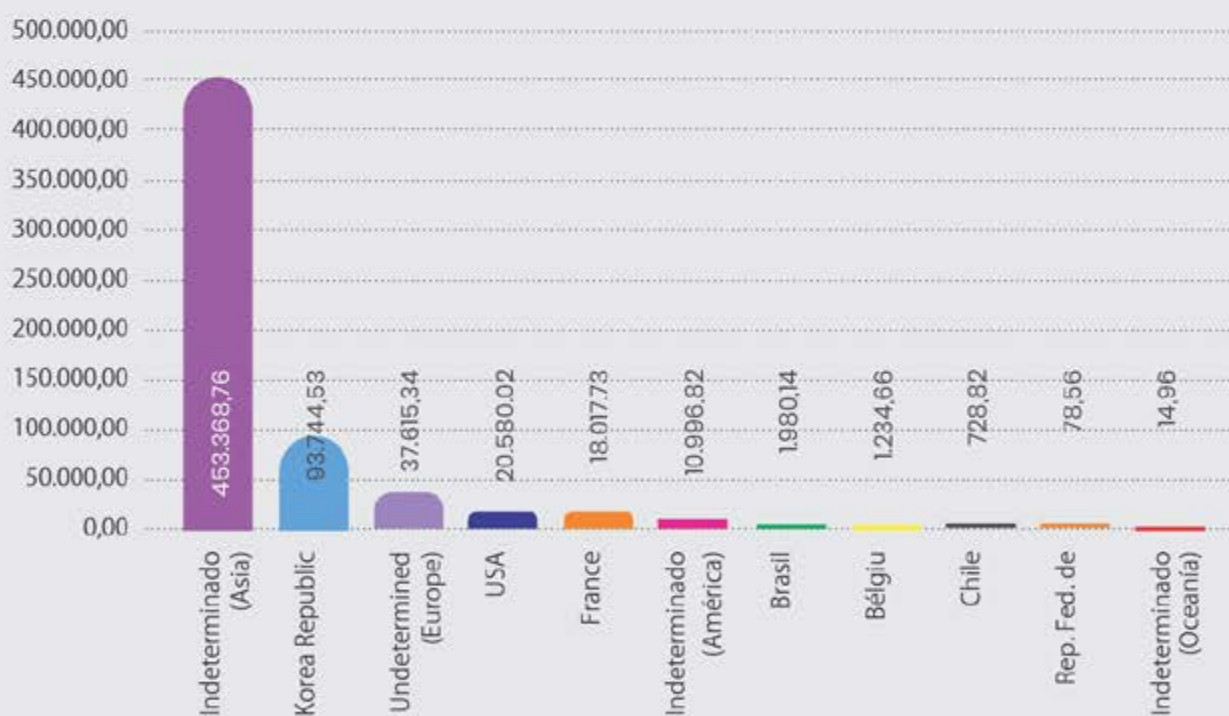

The importance of rainfed crops of grains such as corn, beans and wheat in Jujuy dates back to the mid-1970s, but gained momentum a decade later, when soybean was also incorporated. The development of this area stands out, since its production exceeds 110,000 tons due to the surface planted, which covers over 55,000 hectares.

The destination of these crops is mainly to the external market, and their cultivation is carried out extensively. This means that the producers dedicated to these grains have big enough land areas and the required level of capitalization to handle high production costs (technology package/services/transport to ports), which is possible due to the high profitability these investments provide.

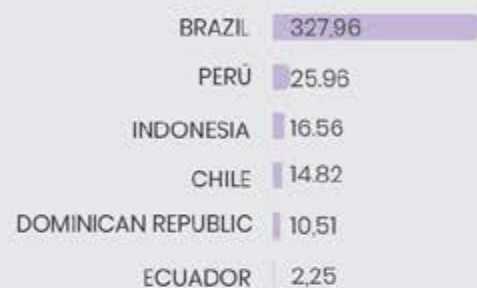

There are 250 productive units in the province, which represent almost 8,000 hectares. The region of Warm Valleys covers 98% of citrus cultivation, all the citrus species are cultivated in the following proportions: 57% oranges, 12% mandarins, 26% lemons, and 5% grapefruit.

One of the companies dedicated to primary production is also vertically integrated, producing concentrated citrus juices and essential oils.

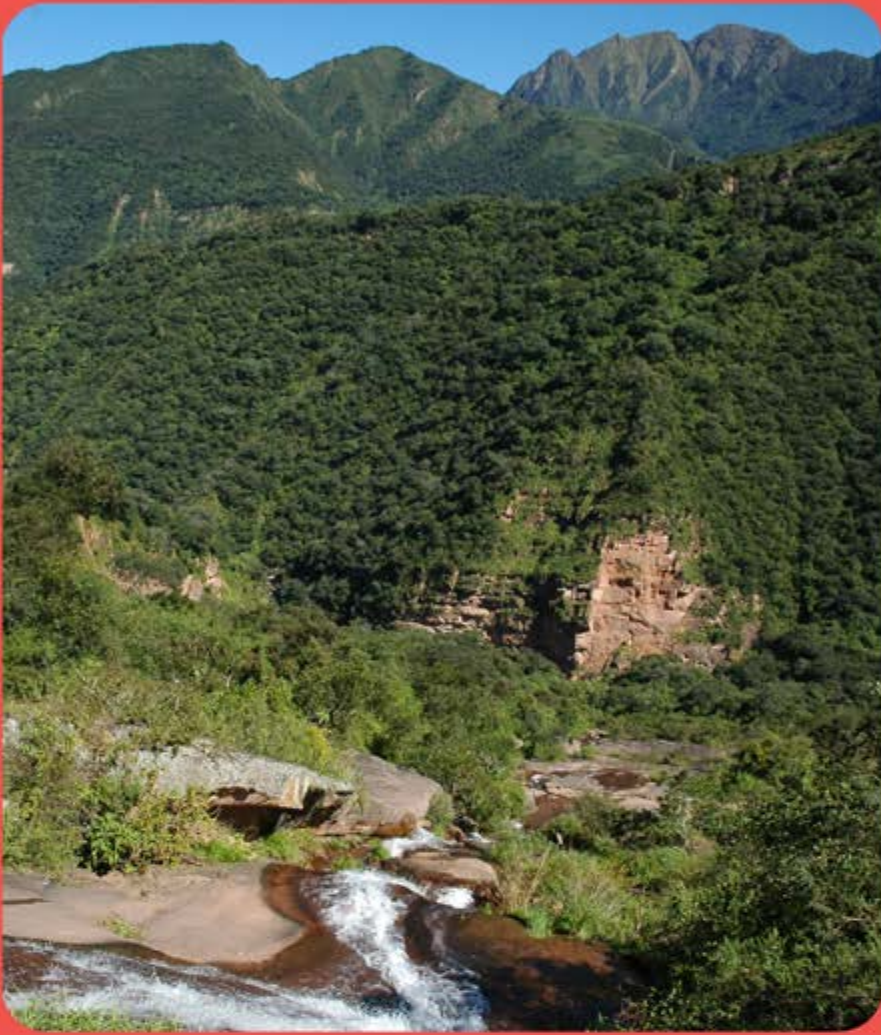

# Mining Sector





Jujuy is a resourceful province, rich in minerals, due to its location near Andes and a favorable tectonic frame. This enabled the occurrence of different mineral deposits, which are reflected today in important deposits of silver, lead and zinc, particularly in the northeast of the province, which are part of the Bolivian Tin Belt.

At the same time, in the Puna, there are endorreic basins on plains with an average height of 3,700 meters and its semi-arid climate, has favored the formation of salt flats, with concentration of minerals such as Boron, Lithium, Sodium and Potassium, with great potential for use.

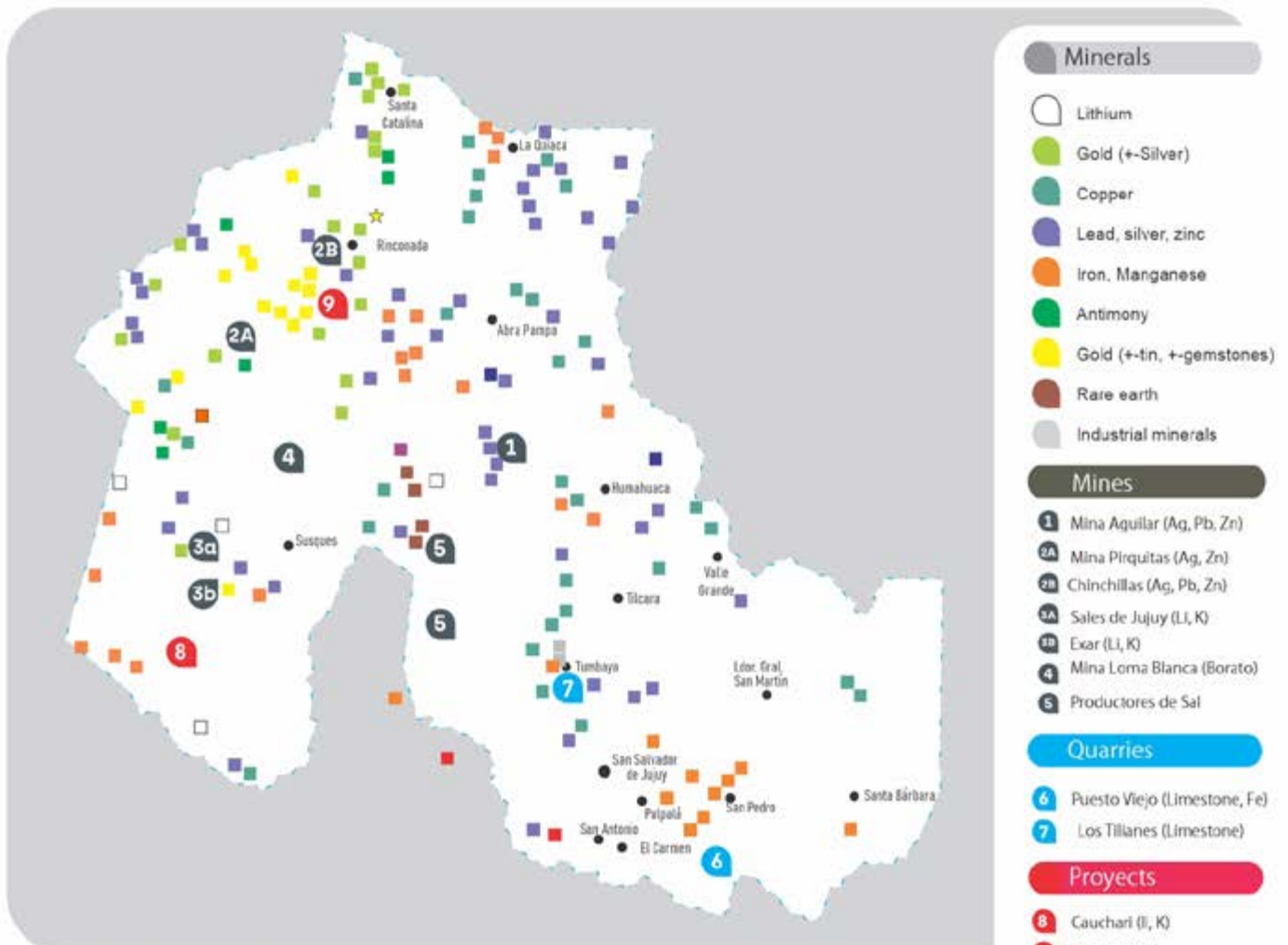
On the other hand, to the east and southeast of the province, there are the Eastern Cordillera, the Sub-Andean Hills and the Santa Barbara System, with the presence of application rocks and industrial minerals, as well as copper deposits. In the section on geological potential, there will be further details regarding the geological provinces.

and main mining districts.

Jujuy has one of the most important mining productions in the country, lithium, silver, lead, zinc, and copper, the main extracted and exported metals. Non-metallic mineral salts, such as borates, and construction stones, like limestone, are also obtained. Most of the establishments that extract, and process minerals are located in the regions of Puna and Quebrada; however, heading to the opposite side, there is a completely different geography where hydrocarbons are extracted, Caimancito.

### Development of Renewable Energies

From a list of 17 minerals that are critical and essential for low-carbon energy technologies, taken from research carried out by the World Bank "Minerals for Climate Action", Jujuy produces 5 of them: Lithium | Silver | Zinc | Lead | Copper.

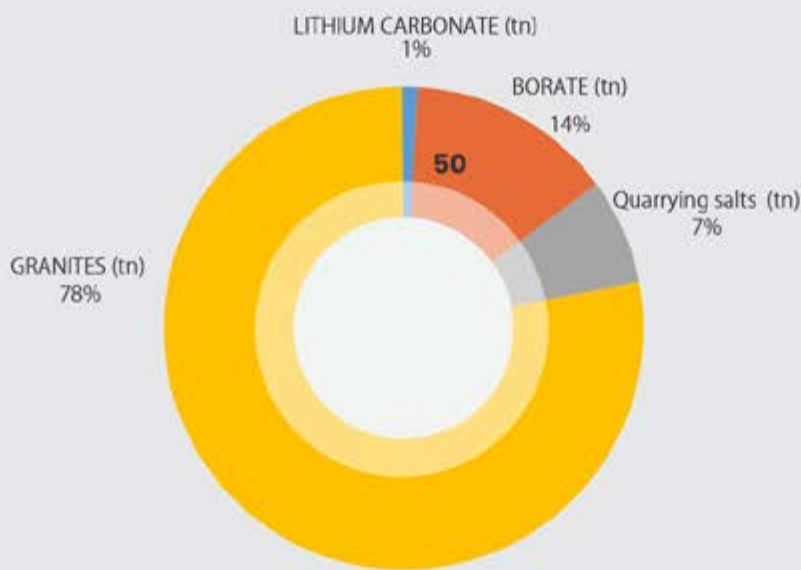
## MAIN COMPLEXES OF DESTINATION FOB PRICE IN MILLION OF US





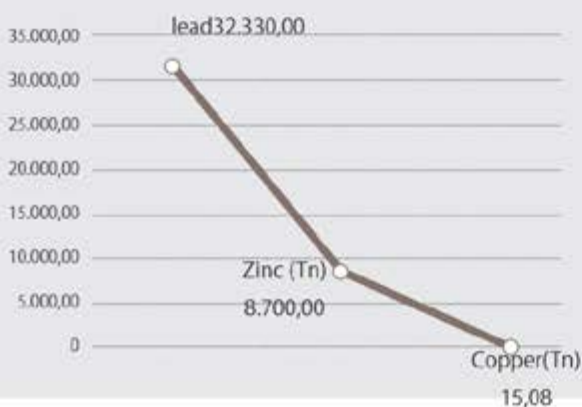


PRODUCTION OF NONMETALLIC MINERALS IN 2023

# Lithium production





Argentina, due to the salt flats of Jujuy, Salta and Catamarca, is located inside the known as the Lithium Triangle, together with Chile and Bolivia.

The province of Jujuy presents a series of interesting characteristics for lithium investment, since it is a prime mining province, with access to international border crossings, gas pipelines and oil pipelines, high-voltage lines close to the salt flats, access via paved national highways, local suppliers already developed near production processes, universities, and laboratories, among other relevant aspects. Currently, there are already operating mining projects that are exporting lithium carbonate, with low production costs.

Jujuy has two operating projects in the Olaroz Cauchari Salt Flat, one of them belongs to the company Sales de Jujuy S.A. and the other, to Minera Exar S.A. Additionally, there is an advanced economic analysis project in the Cauchari Salt Flat (South American Salars S.A) and five exploration projects at various progress stages in the basins of Jama, Salinas Grandes salt flats, and Laguna de Guayatayoc.

Oloaróz- Cauchari salt flat has measured resources of more than 4.6 billion cubic meters of lithium-rich brine with concentrations ranging from 450 to 700 mg/liter.

# Solar Park





Located in Susques, the 1.2 million solar panels will be installed on an 800 hectares surface in the middle of "Puna Jujeña", at more than 4200 masl, in one of the regions that is most exposed to solar radiation.

The dimensions of the Solar Park will be equivalent to half of Buenos Aires city.

Cauchari Solar Park with 315 MW consists of the execution of 3 (three) projects called Cauchari I, II and III of 105 Mw each, which were allocated in Ronda Renovar by the National Ministry of Energy

and Renewable Resources to JESME (Power Company of Jujuy). This company has hired POWERCHINA for the execution of such projects under a turn-key modality.

Cauchari is located in the Department of Susques, at 4,000 masl, in the heart of Jujuy's Puna and about 350 kilometers from the provincial capital city. It is one of the areas with the greatest solar radiation on the planet, with optimal conditions of cold and wind, due to the production and conservation of energy of 1.2 million solar panels.

# Agricultural Sector





## Sugar Cane Production

The sugar cane in Jujuy is cultivated by 120 independent farmers and 3 sugarmills. In the province, it is a crop of a strong cultural identity and a key production for the regional economy.

The sugar-alcohol agro-industrial sector is characterized by being highly concentrated, vertically integrated and highly technical, which also enables it to have a productivity that is higher than the national average.

## Biofuels

The sugar-alcohol industry destines part of its production to the development of anhydrous bioethanol mixed in the fuels produced by oil industries in a proportion of 12%.

Bioethanol is produced by alcohol dehydration, with approximately 5% of water and it is obtained from sugar cane or corn.

The correlation is: one tone of bioethanol is equivalent to 20 tons of sugar cane.

In Argentina, this biofuel is used for the mixture of fuels used in the local market. Within the market for bioethanol produced From sugar cane, there are more than 10 companies in the country with a quota, two of which are from Jujuy.

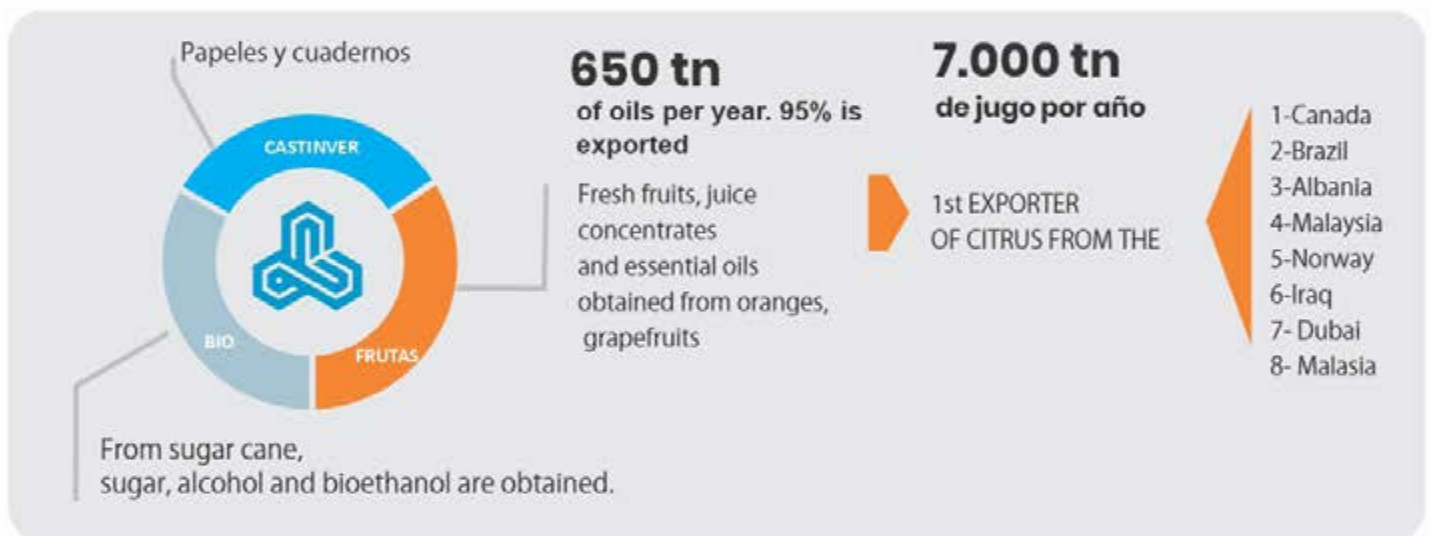


It is an Argentine agro-industrial company with 115 years of history, a leader in the production of sugar and paper, and with a strong presence in the markets of fruit and citrus juices, alcohol, bioethanol, meat, and cereals.

The company is located in Ledesma, hence the name of the company, which headquarters is the city of Libertador General San Martín. The agro-industrial cluster has more than 6,000 employees. They are also present with plants, fields and business in other parts of Argentina.

The Agricultural Business operates in Buenos Aires and Entre Ríos, while the factory in San Luis produces notebooks, as well as school and commercial paper.

Ledesma is an agricultural and industrial corporation formed by the following business units: sugar, alcohol, bioethanol, pulp, paper and electrolyte products.





## Río Grande

Río Grande mill is an agro-industrial company, set in the country since 1890, when it was the first harvest. Our main activity is the grow of sugar cane, from which we produce sugar type A, raw sugar for export and ethyl alcohol.

Over the years, Rio Grande sugar mill has positioned with high effectiveness in the market. For example, the time used in the milling operation can be highlighted, which is, on average, greater than 95.5%.

The company has more than 850 employees, being the biggest mill in the country regarding

the amount of cane and sugar per hectare. Its production capacity reaches 92,000 tons of sugar per year and more than 19,000,000 liters of alcohol.

Currently, Río Grande sugar mill activities are developed in a surface of more than 27,000 hectares, 5,300 of which are planted with sugar cane. Of the total amount of processed sugar cane, 75% is internal production and the remaining amount comes from independent farmers.

The sugar mill is located in La Mendieta, province of Jujuy, and the business offices are located in Capital Federal.



## La Esperanza sugar mill

It is located in the heart of San Pedro, Jujuy. This season, a very good sugar cane harvest is expected. In addition, export contracts have been signed for 450 thousand tons of sugar. The regulatory frame of biofuels is under review, where the governments of the provinces that produce sugar

defend the incorporation of a 12% of bioethanol in fuels blendings, with a contribution of 6% of cane bioethanol.

Demand for sugar in the domestic market has recently declined, perhaps as a result of some stock accumulation or the drop-in general activity, although annual consumption has traditionally not registered significant changes





**Tabacco**  
Sector



The production of tobacco in the province of Jujuy is located in the following departments: Dr. Manuel Belgrano, Santa Bárbara, San Pedro, San Antonio, and, mainly, El Carmen. There are ore than 900 producers of tobacco, with around 12,000 hectares planted that are worked intensively. The tobacco of Jujuy efficiency is, in average, of 2.5 tons per hectare. From sowing to harvest and curing, this plant requires suitable soil and climate, with abundant irrigation and permanent care.

**Horticulture**  
Sector



Jujuy has natural comparative advantages that enable the production of early crops to supply urban markets both within the province and the rest of the country. The province has three well-defined production areas with particular agro-ecological characteristics that differentiate the destination and mode of commercialization for each of them.

The subtropical area or ramal or yungas allows for “off-season” production, supplying large national markets during the winter and early spring. This region is the most important in terms of production. The peak production period extends from May to September, since the area is characterized by low frequency and intensity of frosts.

In the remaining regions of the province, there are vegetable production hubs; their output is destined for self-consumption and supplying local markets.

At the other end, the Quebrada de Humahuaca area

provides vegetables to the regional market during the Summer.

In Quebrada, vegetables such as garlic, carrots, leafy greens, broad beans, peas, zucchini, broccoli, peppers, celery, and radishes are produced.

The third area is the “Temperate Valley”, one mid area that supply products during Autumn until the first frosts (INTA, Yuto.) There, chili peppers, tomatoes, bell peppers, green onions, carrots, potatoes, green beans, common beans, and broad beans are produced, making this region the second most important planted area in the province.

In the Puna region, horticulture is limited due to the prevailing agro-ecological conditions; however, crops that resist the low temperatures and water deficits characteristic of the area, such as potatoes, broad beans, and peas, are still produced.



## Tomatoe

This crop, within the horticultural sector, holds the greatest importance in the province due to the volume of production and the area planted. The Warm Valleys region concentrates the largest proportion of planted area, followed by extends

from April to October, which enables the supply to the Central Market of Buenos Aires in times of shortage. Given the agro-climatic qualities of our province, this product benefits from being an early crop.



In the province, the cultivation of species that make up Andean crops (Andean potatoes, oca, corn, quinoa, yacón) is developed in combination with livestock farming, constituting the basis of the diet for many family farming households. Producers are making efforts to add value to these crops and enter the formal market, as is the case with the quinoa producers from Cusi Cusi and Pirquitas, and the Andean potato producers from Casti and surrounding areas.





Tropical and subtropical fruit growing in the national Norwest region is considered an activity of great agricultural importance, due to its impact in regional economies. In recent years, it has been widely disseminated and adopted as an alternative activity to the traditional crops in the area, such as vegetables and citrus fruits. In this sense, it has allowed the employment of labor, machinery, infrastructure, etc., throughout the entire annual cycle, making more efficient use of resources and generating more income for the area.

## Mango

It is a fruit with a good climatic adaptation and commerce acceptance, great growth perspective, mainly in areas free from frosts in Las Yungas of Jujuy. Argentina is not a self-supply country; there is a product demand in the national market, but this fruit cannot enter the Patagonia region, due to sanitary barriers. In a short-term period, it could be entered to the southern region by applying hydrothermal treatment.

## Avocado

In Jujuy, the following varieties are produced: Hass, Ettinger, Torres, Tonnage, and Lula. The avocado tree is a secondary activity associated with other fruit trees (citrus, mango, papaya) or horticultural crops.

## Bananos

Banana has become the most consumed fruit in Argentina, with a per capita consumption of 12 kg per person per year.



Banana has become the most consumed fruit in Argentina, with a per capita consumption of 12 kg per year. In Jujuy, it is usually produced in Yuto, Fraile Pintado, and Palma Sola.

## Papaya

It is considered the fruit of good health, and its cultivation has been propagated among producers due to its relatively short cultivation period and its fast return on capital. 100% of papaya producers cultivate papaya as an alternative crop for their principal activity or combined with citrus, vegetables, banana, avocado.

## Tamarillo

Tamarillo, or tree tomato, is a tree or shrub that reaches from 2 to 3 meters high. It has simple big dark rough leaves. The fruit is an egg-shaped berry with juicy pulp with numerous edible seeds inside. It is covered by a smooth, transport-resistant shell, and a bitter-tasting cuticle that must be removed before consumption. Depending on the species, the color varies from orange to purple.

In Argentina, it is known by populations from Las Yungas in the Norwest, that comprise the provinces of Tucumán, Salta and Jujuy, but it is generally unknown elsewhere. In Jujuy, there is a cooperative in Valle Grande that produces packaged products from this noble wild fruit.





Jujuy has an area of 6,000 to 7,000 hectares planted mainly with pine and eucalyptus. A large area of this region is still covered by native forests. They represent ecological and economically critical ecosystems for preserving regional biodiversity and sustainable development, and for providing a range of environmental benefits.

Within the forest-industrial sector, both local wood and wood from other provinces are processed. Regarding exotic wood, 42% is used for pulp, 35% is used for packaging, 19% is used for sawmills and carpentry, and only 4% is used for energy, indicating the immense potential of the sector.

For several years now, Provincial Law n° 5790, that promotes forestry activity, seeks to foster development, showing the provincial government’s interest in encouraging sustainable practices in the sector.

Currently, Forest-industrial Center “Arrayanal” operates within the Ministry of Economic Development and Production, a complex considered the most important in northwestern Argentina (NOA). It provides the services of sawing and edging; it supplies wood to carpenters and local building companies and there is an innovative technology nursery for the production of forestry seedlings.





This sector comprises more than 150 floriculture producers, primarily located in temperate valleys and the Quebrada region, along with nearly 100 nurserymen who grow potted plants. Floriculture in the province is a regional economy of great importance from a social, as well as productive and market point of view. Regarding the cultivated surface, it ranks third in the country and tenth in covered area with plastic. Jujuy region presents suitability for floriculture across its various environmental zones which allows it to produce a wide variety of species.

The production of potted plants is concentrated around populated centers, especially in the surroundings of the capital city of Jujuy.

The nursery sector grew as a result of COVID-19, to the point that it was referred to as the “green pandemic” due to the significant increase in the consumption of ornamental plants. This surge was driven by people’s need to connect with nature, leading them to embrace gardening and home decoration. This effect remains up to the moment.





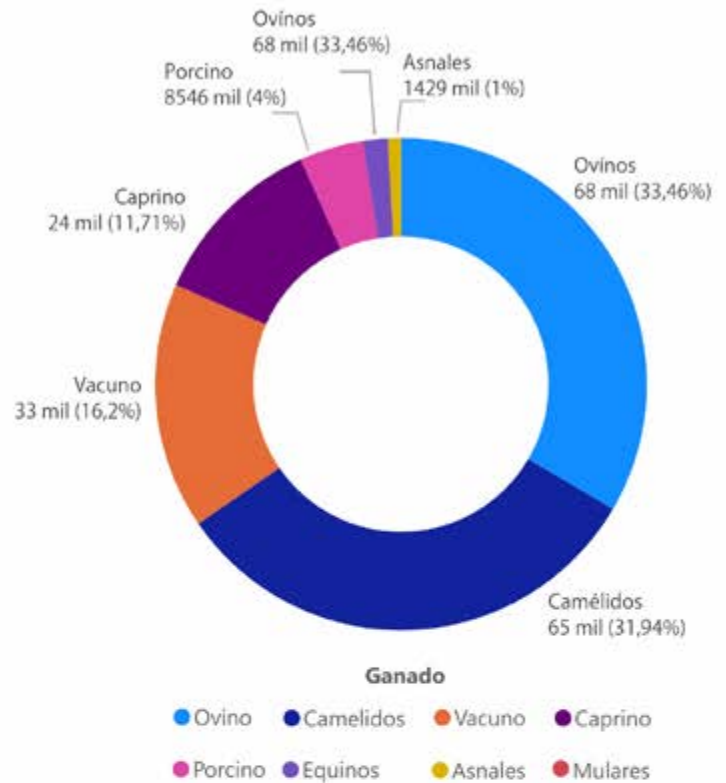

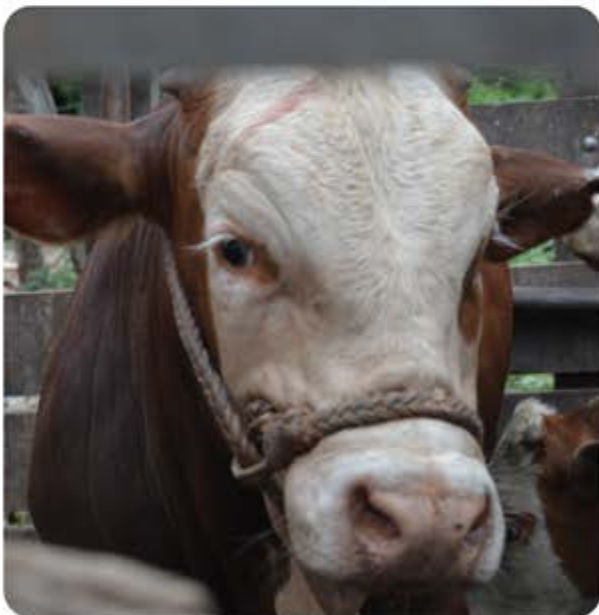


The province of Jujuy, with its diversity of climates, has the potential to produce multiple types of livestock and the policy of the Government is to move forward the true recovery of all the productive areas of the province, working hard in the different areas in order to overcome structural problems that condition the production growth.

The province of Jujuy presents two well differentiated productive areas: Quebrada de Humahuaca Region and Temperate Valleys Region, with contrasting climatic, environmental, cultural and other features that allow for the development of a wide variety of wine products. Currently, there are around 100 hectares are planted with vineyards, distributed as follows:

- 73 hectares in Quebrada de Humahuaca Region.
  - 27 hectares in Temperate Valleys Region.
- In the last 10 years, the planted surface grew by

800%, from 12 hectares in 2013 to 100 hectares in 2023, and it is expected considerable growth.

Regarding the development of wines, according to the classification of the National Viticulture Institute (INV, in Spanish), there are both artisanal and home-based producers in the province.



# Wineries of Quebrada de Humahuaca

The grape production comprises the departments of Tumbaya, Tilcara and Humahuaca, known as the high-altitude wine producing region, starting at 2,000 masl and reaching just over 3,000 masl in the department of Humahuaca.

The climate is temperate, with average temperatures of 12.5° C and a great thermal amplitude between day and night.

Due to the environmental conditions of extreme altitude and sharp thermal amplitude, these wines are intense regarding their colors, aromas and flavor, being these features highlighted in diverse events.

In the region, there are two types of producers with very distinct production systems: one follows a business model, incorporating technological innovation and specialized technical advisors; while the other operates a diversified production system.

The latter is complementary to primary horticultural and livestock production, managed by rural families, indigenous communities, and family farmers, with a focus on sustainable practices and the production of artisanal wines.

Both production systems include both fine and criolla grape varieties, with red varieties being predominant over white ones.

Viticultural production is mainly located in the department of El Carmen, in the towns of Monterrico, Santo Domingo and Ovejería.

Unlike Quebrada, the environmental conditions are mild, with an average annual temperature of 18° C and a low thermal amplitude (around 13° C on average per year.) Rainfall can reach up to 680 mm accumulated throughout the year.

As a result, the wines produced in this region present a marked contrast to those from the Quebrada region. They can be characterized as fresh, young wines, with lower alcohol content, firm aromas, and colors that are distinct yet not intense.

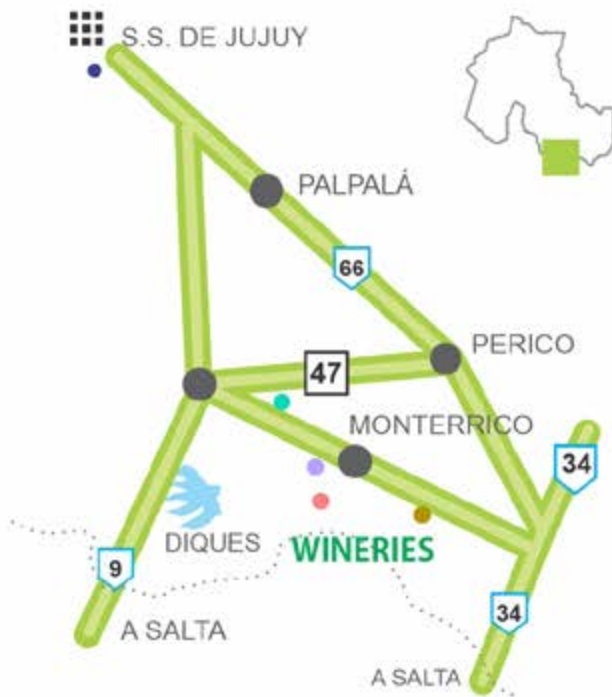
The planted varieties in the region are: Red: Pinot Noir, Malbec, Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Syrah, Caber-

net Sauvignon, Marselan, Cabernet Sauvignon.

White: Sauvignon Blanc, Torrontés, Viognier, Chardonnay.

It is important to notice that the region used to be a wine-growing area, which was then replaced by tobacco. However, there is a recent interest and growth in the region. Viticulture serves as a complement to tobacco farming; this can be seen in the repurposing of some drying sheds into wineries and/or cellars for wine storage.

There are ventures that cover the entire production process (vine cultivation, winemaking, ecotourism) and others that, currently, only focus on primary production but have plans to build an on-site winery in the future.

**Audiovisual**  
Sector

The province of Jujuy aims to become a leading audiovisual hub for the region. Since 2014, it has hosted the International Film Festival “Cine de las Alturas”, an exhibition space with international reach. Since 2015, the National School of Film Experimentation and Production (ENERC NOA campus) has been operating and, since 2017, the Film Commission has been active.

With the approval of the Provincial Audiovisual Law in 2021 (No. 6250), the Jujuy Institute of Audiovisual Arts (IAAJ, in Spanish) was created, playing a fundamental role by providing a series of benefits to the sector through the Jujuy Audiovisual Plan. This annual development plan includes contests, grants, programs, and training aimed at promoting the production of audiovisual works and fostering the growth of local culture and industry.

In turn, the province is a filming destination sought by national and international productions, which find in Jujuy a variety of unique locations,

efficient infrastructure and skilled professionals.

Such geographic and cultural features complement with incentives such as “Cash Rebate,” a reimbursement of 30% of expenses carried out in the province (with a limit of 80 million). Through the contracting of services in different areas, such as hotels, gastronomy, technical services and local artists, the program seeks to contribute to the sustainable economic growth.

In recent years, this context has favored the creation of more audiovisual content in the province, the formation of companies linked to the audiovisual sector located in Jujuy and to the professional training of local technicians and artists. Since the creation of the Commission, more than 100 cinema productions have been made. Some of them are: “My Masterpiece”, “Pipa”, “Lost and Found” and some series such as “Night Sky” (Prime Video), “El Reino” (Netflix), “The World’s Most Dangerous Roads” (Warner Netherlands), and commercials such as “An Ancestral Path” (ARRI), “Argentina en la Piel” (Adidas) and “En este suelo hay fútbol” (YPF).

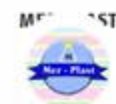

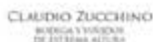
